10th Annual Dream Makers Gala Raises Over \$222,000 to Support Stomach Cancer Research, Patients, and Families

Debbie's Dream Foundation Celebrated a Decade of Helping Patients and Families and Funding Research

Fort Lauderdale, Fla. – (May 17, 2019) – Debbie's Dream Foundation: Curing Stomach Cancer (DDF) celebrated its 10th Annual Dream Makers Gala on Saturday, May 4, 2019, at the Margaritaville Hollywood Beach Resort in Hollywood, Florida. With 316 registrants, more than \$222,000 was raised to fund research and support stomach cancer patients and families worldwide. "It makes me feel proud to know that DDF will continue its relentless commitment to finding a cure for this disease through honoring the legacy of my dear friend Debbie Zelman, who founded this organization."

DDF was founded in 2009 by Debbie Zelman after she was diagnosed with stage IV incurable gastric cancer in 2008 and given only weeks to live. She did all of this while receiving hundreds of rounds of chemo, in addition to daily oral treatments. Debbie passed away on December 23, 2017, at the age of 50, almost a decade later. As a result of her leadership, DDF now has a Scientific and Medical Advisory Board of world-renowned doctors and chapters throughout the United States and in Canada and Germany.
