In addition to providing consultations and follow-up care for Lasik and cataract surgeries, Dr. Falco can examine the back of your eye for signs of high cholesterol, hypertension, diabetes, and other inflammatory systemic conditions, like rheumatoid arthritis. "Our state-of-the-art equipment can find subtle signs of early macular degeneration before any patient or doctor, as it measures swelling in the back of the eye by the micron," said Dr. Falco. "We can then connect patients with the right doctor or surgeon to correct the issue."

And if you are in need of glasses, the selection at Jazzy Eyes is unparalleled, with more than 3000 high-quality frames in their double-bay, retro-cool location.
