Whereas, stomach cancer is among the cancers with the lowest five-year survival rates; and

Whereas, out of 27,600 new cases diagnosed a year in the United States, 11,010 will die in the first year of diagnosis; and

Whereas, most stomach cancers are diagnosed at stage IV which only has a 5% five year survival rate; and

Whereas, in the United States it is estimated that more than 116,525 people are currently living with stomach cancer; and

Whereas, stomach cancer has increased in young adults ages 25 to 39 by 70 percent since 1977; and

Whereas, overall survival rate for stomach cancer is 32 percent; stomach cancer mortality rates have remained relatively unchanged over the past 30 years; and

Whereas, stomach cancer continues to be one of the leading causes of cancer related death;
